**WHEREAS** Justin S. Monaghan, PE, joined the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) in 1995 and for over 14 years, faithfully carried the ASCE banner advocating community and professional involvement;

**WHEREAS**, Justin earned his BS degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Rhode Island (URI) in Providence in 1996 and continued his education to earn a MS in Geotechnical Engineering from URI in 1998;

**WHEREAS**, in 1998 Justin began his career at GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc. starting as a practicing geotechnical engineer and advancing up to Project Manager;

**WHEREAS**, Justin was an active member in the Rhode Island engineering committee, serving as an active younger member in the ASCE RI Section and advancing himself to President in 2007-2008 and he was also a member of ASCE's Geolnstitute, the National Society of Professional Engineers, the Providence Engineering Society, and the Association of State Dam Safety Officials;

**WHEREAS**, Justin was a strong advocate and recognized the importance of professional licensure, serving on the NCEES civil engineering examination committee;

**WHEREAS**, Justin received recognition for his outstanding contributions as the RI Society of Professional Engineers 2007 Young Engineer of the Year;
