WHEREAS, the New York State Council of the American Society of Civil Engineers represents over 6,600 design professional members living and practicing in New York State, and


WHEREAS, the practice of engineering is regulated by the New York State Department of Education to ensure that those participating in the practice of engineering satisfy rigorous requirements of education, experience, and examination currently required by law, and

WHEREAS, TAP Awards are awarded by the State Education Department to aid students progressing to degrees,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill A07771 provides an additional TAP award to students who pursue degrees in mathematics, the physical sciences, or engineering.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the New York State Council of the American Society of Civil Engineers strongly recommends passage of Assembly Bill A07771.
