Resolution 2006 – 01

WHEREAS, New York State has instituted a continuing education requirement for renewal of Professional Engineering registration;

WHEREAS, New York State recognizes ASCE through its IACET certification as a provider for New York State Continuing Competency requirements;

WHEREAS, ASCE Sections and Branches provide continuing education courses for their members that are eligible for approval and certification by the Practicing Institute of Engineering, Inc (PIE);

WHEREAS, Effective May 2006, PIE only maintains records for its members on a course-by-course fee basis;

WHEREAS, ASCE Section and Branches develop and sponsor programs for their local members that can meet PIE certification requirements and are now subject to new costs associated with having PIE maintain records;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ASCE provide guidelines to its Sections and Branches on how to perform program evaluations of planned continuing education courses and seminars for compliance with New York State continuing education unit requirements under ASCE's IACET certification.
