#### RESOLUTION 2007 – 01

#### GUIDELINES FOR HONORARY FELLOW

**WHEREAS**, the Region 1 Board of Governors represents the interests of approximately 18,900 members residing within New England, New Jersey, New York, and Puerto Rico; and

**WHEREAS**, an important function of Region 1 is to serve as a central communication network for its Sections and Branches; and

**WHEREAS**, a list of candidates was recently submitted to the ASCE Executive Board of Direction to bestow the title of Honorary Fellow upon six elected government members of Congress and the Senate for specific accomplishments that demonstrate an understanding and exhibit leadership on issues affecting civil engineering, one of whom resides in Region 1; and

**WHEREAS**, ASCE's Honorary Fellows program does not have known published guidelines other than the language published in the ASCE Official Register; and

**WHEREAS**, the Region 1 Board of Governors recognizes that Society initiatives can sometimes be in conflict with local interests; and

**WHEREAS**, the Region 1 Board of Governors supports the inclusion of a letter of endorsement from an ASCE geographic entity as part of the nomination process; and

**WHEREAS**, other professional organizations that confer this type of honorary award to non-members do so for sustained contributions to their respective organizations and confer this honor through a Nominating Committee who follow published guidelines and evaluation criteria; now

**THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the Region 1 Board of Governors recommends that a Task Committee be established to develop national guidelines for the ASCE Honorary Fellow program that include candidate qualification guidelines, nomination procedures, and nominating committee evaluation criteria; and

**THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the formation of such task committee should include Region Governors.
